Breakfast & Lunch

Eloy Elementary School District will offer healthy meals to all students at **no cost** every school day in the 2025 - 2026 school year. Your children will receive a free breakfast in the classroom and lunch in the cafeteria every school day without having to pay for a meal or submit a household application.

Snacks

Students will also receive a **free** snack at the end of every school day in the 2025–2026 school year. Students will take the snack home.

Supper Program

The supper program will start on September 8, 2025. The **free** meals will be available at the Junior High School cafeteria from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday on school days. The meals are available to all students who are 18 years of age and younger. Students must eat the meal on-site.
