2025 - 2026 Open Enrollment applications are now available for kindergarten through 8th grade for the 2025 - 2026 school year for the Eloy Elementary School District.

EESD accepts open enrollment applications from parents wishing to have their child attend EESD school from parents from other school districts wishing to have their child considered for enrollment in EESD. Applications for Open Enrollment will be considered based on the criteria outlined in [Governing Board Policy JFB](#).

- Contact the school in which you wish to enroll.

Complete the [Open Enrollment Attendance Application](#) available from the front office at each school and submit it to the registrar of the school no later than June 30.

Please note that:

- Enrollment is subject to the capacity limit established for the school and/or its grade levels.
- On or before August 15, the parent or legal guardian will be notified in writing whether the application has been accepted, rejected, or placed on a waiting list.
- Transportation for the student is the responsibility of the parents or legal guardian. The school will not provide transportation.
- Providing false information on this form may result in the application being denied or admission being revoked.

EESD gives enrollment preference to and reserves capacity for all of the following:

- Resident pupils.
- Pupils returning to school from the prior year.
- Siblings of pupils already enrolled.

EESD also provides enrollment preference for children who:

- Are in foster care.
- Meet the definition of unaccompanied youth prescribed in the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (P.L. 100-77; 101 Stat. 482; 42 United States Code Section 11434a).

Except as provided in A.R.S. [15-816.01](#), a school that is operated by a school district may not limit admission based on any of the following:

- Ethnicity or race.
- National origin.
- Sex.
- Income level.

- Disability.
- Proficiency in the English language.
- Athletic ability.

There is no cost to enroll.

- Proof of Residency (utility bill - APS electric, water, sanitation OR lease agreement)
- Court Custody Documents (if applicable)
